



Measuring any room can be difficult and it is important for our designers to get the most accurate dimensions possible. Here is our step by step guide to assist you and make the process more manageable.

STEP 1 -

Draw an outline of the shape of your chosen room and measure the dimensions of each wall, please note whether they are external or internal.

STEP 2 -

If possible, also record the measurement of the ceiling height, this can be achieved by taking the measurement in the middle of the ceiling to get an average height.

STEP 3 -

Add in the sizes and locations of your windows. These should include: the height of the window, the height of your window sill and the distance from the closest wall (i.e. distance from the left 500mm).

STEP 4 -

Add in the sizes and locations of your doors/passages. These should include: the direction the door swings or where the hinge is placed, the height, the width and, again, the placement of the door.

STEP 5 -

Measure any possible obstructions. These may be: a boiler, electric meter, radiators or any beams. Take the height, width and depth and note where these are located.

STEP 6 -

Lastly, please take a final check of all your measurements and note any other possible obstructions (i.e. light switches).

NOTE:

Please make sure your measurements are in millimetres as this is what our manufacturers use.
